



Brewery Tour of Cambridge & Harvard

A fun way to experience two prominent areas of Boston is by taking a tour of the most popular breweries in Cambridge & Harvard! On this brew adventure, we have mapped out several breweries using the T and other local forms of transportation as a suggested route. Please feel free to Lyft/Uber if that is more suitable for you.

Directions to Rock Bottom from Found Hotel Boston Common (3 min):

- Make a RIGHT when exiting our property onto Charles St.
- Make a RIGHT at the next cross-street onto Stuart St. Rock Bottom will be located on your LEFT-hand side at 115 Stuart St.

1. Rock Bottom: A great place to start on your brew tour of Boston, simply because it is the closest brewery located to Found Hotel Boston Common. Here you can find an array of craft beer on tap. We suggest that you try one of their season brews! **Operating hours are Sunday-Thursday 11am-12am and Friday & Saturday 11am-1am.**

Directions from Rock Bottom to Cambridge Brewing Company (20 min):

- Exit Rock Bottom and make a LEFT onto Stuart St.
- Make a LEFT onto Tremont St
- The Red Line T station will be located on your LEFT-hand side
- Take the Red Line T towards ALEWIFE
- Take the Red Line T TWO stops to KENDALL/MIT
- Head towards Main St and make a LEFT
- Turn RIGHT onto Ames St.
- Turn LEFT onto Broadway
- Turn RIGHT onto Hampshire St

- Cambridge Brewing Company will be on your RIGHT-hand side at 1 Kendal Square

2. Cambridge Brewing Company: As our second stop, the Cambridge Brewing Company has lavishly designed beer bottles and a fun atmosphere. If you're hungry, this is a GREAT place to stop and grab some pub food! Exceptional rotating beer on tap, you can't go wrong with anything you choose! **Open from Tuesday-Thursday 11:30am-12am, Sunday & Monday 11:30am-11pm, Friday 11:30am-12:45am and Saturday 11am-12:45am.**

Directions from Cambridge Brewing Company to Lamplighter Brewing Co. (8min):

- Exit Cambridge Brewing Company and make a LEFT onto Portland St.
- Make a RIGHT onto Broadway
- Lamplight Brewing Co. will be located on your LEFT-hand side just after Columbia St at 284 Broadway

3. Lamplighter Brewing Co.: The next stop on our brew trek is at the Lamplighter. If you're a fan of tart beer, check out their Sound & Vision brew. **Their taproom is open Tuesday-Saturday 11am-12am and Sunday 11am-10pm.**

Directions from Lamplighter Brewing Co to John Harvard's Brewery & Ale House (15 min):

- Exit the Lamplighter and make a LEFT onto Broadway
- Make a LEFT onto Norfolk St.
- Make a RIGHT onto Massachusetts Ave.
- Catch the Red Line T at their CENTRAL station
- Take the T towards ALEWIFE for one stop
- Exit at Harvard and make a LEFT out of the station towards Dunster St
- Make a RIGHT onto Dunster St
- John Harvard's Brewery & Ale House will be located on the RIGHT-hand side at 33 Dunster St.

4. John Harvard's Brewery & Ale House: This tour will take you to one of Boston's most iconic locations, Harvard Square. Here, you will find John Harvard's Brewery & Ale House where we recommend enjoying the Dunster Pale Ale just before heading over to the Harvard University to take a tour of the beautiful red-bricked campus. **Hours are Sunday & Monday 11:30am-11pm, Monday-Thursday 11:30am-12am and Friday & Saturday 11:30am-1am.**

You can either STOP here or continue on to our last stop on the tour at Aeronaut Brewing Co.

Directions from John Harvard's Brewery & Ale House to Aeronaut Brewing Co. (15 min):

- Exit John Harvard's and head back to where the Red Line T dropped you off and take the 86 bus towards Sullivan for 5 stops.
- Exit the bus at Washington St @ Beacon St and make a RIGHT onto Washington St towards Dane St
- Make a LEFT onto Dane St
- At the fork, continue on to Dane St
- Make a LEFT onto Tyler St
- Aeronaut Brewing Company will be located on your LEFT-hand side at 14 Tyler St

5. Aeronaut Brewing Company: With events happening every night that they are open, Aeronaut promises to be a place where one can find a goodtime. They have a wide selection of brews that are not only well designed but innovative. Try any one of their many flights to better grasp what truly makes an Aeronaut brew! **Their taproom is open Monday 6pm-12am, Tuesday 5pm-12am, Friday 5pm-13:30am, Saturday 12pm-12:30am and Sunday 12am-8pm.**

For the quickest route back to Found Hotel Boston Common, a Lyft/Uber is suggested (20 min). Taking public transportation will take 45 min.
